
2014 State of Ohio Leadership State Conference/Meeting

I want to remind everyone that this is an election year, and as stated by our Constitution, Article III Section 1: The elected officers of The Chapter shall be the President, 1st Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Chaplain, and Sergeant-at-Arms. Section 4 reads: No officers, with the exception of parliamentarian (appointed), may serve more than two (2) successive terms. As such, the election cycle shall proceed as follows: October Meeting: Nominations of Officers for '15-'16, November Meeting: Presentations from nominees on qualifications, etc. December Meeting: Closed elections January Meeting (or Founders Day Program): Installation of New Officers.

Hough's Historic League Park Grand Reopening

The brothers of Gamma Alpha Sigma chapter participated In a momentous event on August 23rd, 2014 as League Park in Cleveland's Hough neighborhood held it's grand Re-opening. For those who are unfamiliar with the Significance of the baseball field, League Park Which was built in 1891 and once known as Dunn Field, Is baseball's oldest existing Major League ball Grounds. It also is the first former Major League Park turned into a community park. It was the site Of numerous key moments in baseball history, Including the Indians 1920 World Series Championship, Babe Ruth's 500th career home run, Joe DiMaggio's 56th consecutive hit. A long list of Hall of Famers called it home or visited, from Cy Young, to Satchel Paige, to Feller. The NFL's Cleveland Rams played there, as did the Negro League champion Buckeyes. Even the Browns Practiced at League Park. After the Indians Abandoned it in 1946 and the Buckeyes folded a Few years later, most of the stadium that held more Than 19,000 fans was torn down in the 1950s. On August 23rd, 2014 Bro T.J. Dow, councilman of Cleveland's Ward 7 neighborhood which houses the Hough Community along with other politicians, local leaders



And, other individual's gave remarks in the historic reopening of the legendary field. Bro. T.J. also gave congratulations and commendations on the 100 year centennial anniversary of Phi Beta Sigma in his presentation acknowledging the fraternity in his presentation. Surely the history and legacy of League Park is alive and well within the Hough neighborhood and will be for years to come with Bro. T.J. Dow doing what he can for his community and constituents. It is moments like this where men who have been called to carry the blue and white banner of Sigma not only show up and show out for the frat but our ultimate cause for the betterment of others as expressed in our motto "culture for service and service for humanity".
